Lynne Pavlic Marshall is a Research Statistician at Gateway Health, where her responsibilities range from study design to statistical analysis and support. She works on projects that center around using data to improve the health and wellbeing of Gateway Health members. Dr. Marshall designs strategies to identify and assist members who are particularly vulnerable due to their medical, social, economic, and environmental circumstances. She also implements and evaluates new and existing interventions. Dr. Marshall holds a Doctoral degree in epidemiology from the University of Pittsburgh, where her Area of Emphasis was environmental epidemiology; she studied under Dr. Evelyn Talbott. She worked at the Allegheny County Health Department conducting research in the Air Quality Program before accepting to her current position in managed healthcare.

She also holds a Bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from Penn State University and a Master's degree in environmental science and management from Duquesne University.
