1. Explain your interest in public health and why you would like to participate in PHUSP. Tell us how participating will help you achieve your future academic or career goals. (200 words/1000 character max)

2. PHUSP makes every effort to provide scholars with an internship placement that is a strong match. Matches are based upon each scholar's experience and academic background, preference for a research- vs practice-based experience, and any special skills needed for the internship. What are your expectations for the internship? How would you react or feel if the internship you are matched with does not meet your personal expectations? (200 words/1000 character max)

3. Describe how your identities and experiences have influenced your community service, leadership roles, academic interest and/or research activities. (200 words/1000 character max)
